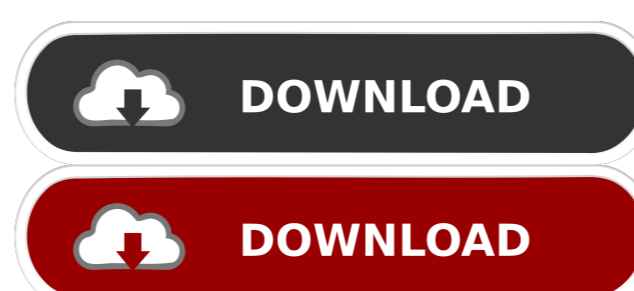

Q: Laravel 5.4 Eloquent not working as expected with the group by I have this query in Laravel and I'm trying to get all the servers by country. \$servers = Server::where('country', \$country) ->orderBy('name', 'ASC') ->get(); \$serversCountries = \$this->countries()->get(); And the relationships: Server.php public function countries() { return \$this->belongsToMany('Country'); } Country.php public function servers() return \$this->hasMany('Server'); And the dd(\$servers); is just returning an empty array. I've tried the same exact code and it works, the only difference is that i just use the id from the request and not the variable and it works: \$servers = Server::where('country_id', \$id) The same thing is happening when i use the whereIn: \$servers = Server::whereIn('country', \$serversCountries) I am using Laravel 5.4 A: I think the problem is in that you have a whereIn in your query, but the variable you are passing in has values. I think you want: // this variable has a key value pair of countries, if you wanted to use // a query to get all countries, then you should do it like this: \$countries = \$this->countries(); \$servers = Server::whereIn('country', \$countries) ->orderBy('name', 'ASC') ->get(); And, by the way, whereIn requires that the values you want to search are strings, so: \$countries = \$this->countries()->get(); \$serversCount 82157476af
